EAGLE STEPS

Eagle Candidate – should attend the **Life to Eagle** class presented via Zoom Meeting every 2^{nd} Thursday of the month from 6:30 - 7:30 pm. The Zoom link is on the council calendar event and this class is free.

Eagle Candidate - must attend an **Eagle Project Approval Session** with their **Service Area** Advancement Chair — These are located on the council calendar HERE.

Eagle Candidate - once their project has been approved, they need to complete their project. Then finish filling out the balance of their Eagle Workbook.

Eagle Candidate – next needs to turn in his/her Eagle Workbook and Eagle Application to the Council Office. Make sure that the Eagle Rank Application and the Eagle Workbook are current in the lower right corner of the back side or MOST CURRENT per National BSA website HERE. Make sure there is a Letter of Ambition. Make sure that the Approval page has all signatures with a date. Make sure that the Fundraising page has all signatures with a date if you intended to fundraise. Make sure Candidate's Promise page has all signatures and date. (Reference EAGLE BOOK PROCESSING for further details.)

After it is turned in to the Council it will be checked over by the Registrar and then the **District/Service Area Advancement Chair** will notify the Candidate as to when his **Board of Review** will be scheduled.

Eagle Candidate – Will attend his Board of Review and then the Eagle Application with all signatures needs to be turned into the Council Office. It will then be entered and sent to **National BSA**. Approximately 2 weeks later the Eagle Certificate will be sent back the Council and our Registrar will send a notice to the **Scoutmaster** that it is in and available for pick up.

Unit may then go to the **Hibbard Scout Shop** to purchase the **Eagle Award Presentation Kit.** Next step would be an **Eagle Court of Honor**. Council has some decorations available to borrow for the Court of Honor.
