Annually, Scouting for Food collects over **40,000** pounds of food for families in need



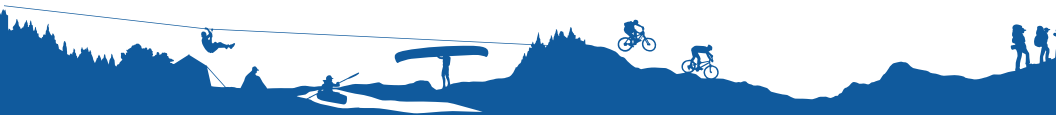

Tinsel & Trees Family Fest

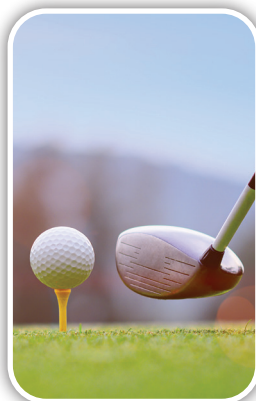
Date: December 2024

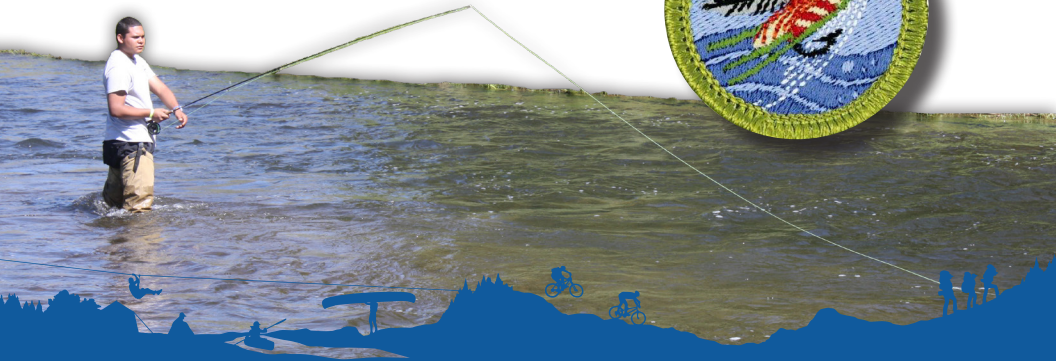
