2025 NATIONAL YOUTH LEADERSHIP TRAINING (NYLT) SCHOLARSHIP APPLICATION

Pathway to the Rockies Council and the Wood Badge Scouters of the Council strongly believe no eligible Scout should have to forego attending National Youth Leadership Training (NYLT) because of lack of funds. A Wood Badge Scholarship Fund has been established to provide financial assistance to those who would not otherwise be able to attend this training. The only obligation on the part of those receiving scholarships is to complete the course they attend and to do their best to apply what they learn to help other youth in your unit and our community. We encourage you to also look at other outside funding assistance from your unit, church, or other organizations.

Scholarship Policy/Procedures:

Application Submitted for:

- 1. Scholarships are available only for Pathway to the Rockies Council National Youth Leadership Training courses.
- 2. Full scholarships are not available. An applicant or the unit must pay the course deposit. The amount awarded to an individual will vary based on the amount of funding available and number of requests.
- 3. Fill out this application form completely. Return it to the Council Service Center, marked for the Wood Badge Coordinator or send by email to WBTroop1@gmail.com.
- 4. Requests should be submitted as soon as possible and at least 45 days prior to the course opening date to ensure consideration. Scholarships will not be awarded after attending a course.
- 5. A participant's portion of course fees must be paid by a deadline established by the course director but at least 30 days prior to the beginning of the course.
