- The change went fully into effect on February 8th, 2025, the organizations 115th anniversary.



- The entire Cub Scout program received an overhaul in 2024 with a focus on streamlining the program and making it fun, easy, and simple for youth and adult leaders.
- The Pathway to the Rockies council continued our Den in a Box program for our Den Leaders to empower them to spend more time delivering the program and less time planning.


