GUIDELINES FOR EAGLE LETTERS OF RECOMMENDATION

Roy L. Williams, past Chief Scout Executive, stated; “The list of references of people will speak on the candidate’s behalf.” The words contained in the letters of recommendation are traditionally a testimonial that the Eagle Scout candidate has indeed achieved the necessary character outside the world of Scouting. This is the only time in a Scout’s trail to Eagle that non-scouting persons are asked to formally comment about the Scout’s character.

In compliance with the Eagle Scout Rank Application requirement 2, the Eagle Scout candidate is asked to make available to the Board of Review a written letter from each of the persons listed on the application. It is the Scout who lists the references, and it is their decision as to whom they will be. Your unit leader or Committee Chair are not allowed to provide references and parents/guardians are strongly discouraged to provide a reference.

The candidate will be provided the appropriate form letter for each letter of recommendation. This form or a personal letter from the reference is available. These forms are available at the Life to Eagle class, at the council service center, or on the council website. The candidate is responsible for assuring that all their references are given the form for the letter in sufficient time to allow delivery to Pathway to the Rockies Council prior to the Board of Review.

The name of the Eagle Scout candidate should be written on the lower left corner of the envelope. The letters will be opened by the registrar and transported to the Board of Review by the district person who picks up the completed Eagle Scout binders from council. All letters will be read by the Board of Review members only and will be destroyed by the district person upon completion of the Eagle Scout Board of Review and the receipt of the Eagle Scout certification form from the nation office. The process must be followed even if the Scout runs out of time for a Board of Review and must request that National allows their Board of Review beyond the 180 day period following their 18th birthday.
