Eagle Scout/Summit Award Recognition Dinner:

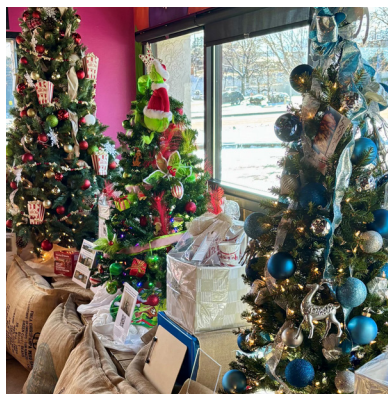

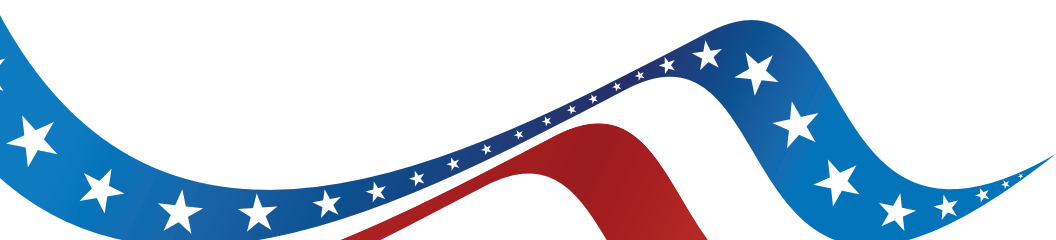
